

# Jesus worldwide

## Isaiah 49:1–50:3

### 1. What Jesus want to tell people worldwide about Himself (49:1–6)

- His whole life is shaped by God to speak words of great power (1–2)
- He is the perfect channel for God's beauty to be seen (3)
- He has had to move from frustration to hope (4)
- The bright light of his rescue plan shines worldwide (5–6)

### 2. What God wants to tell people worldwide about Jesus (49:7–13)

- He is seen as insignificant and repugnant but He will win (7)
- He embodies God's new binding commitment to bring global freedom (8–12)
- He shows us such comforting compassion that the whole universe will applaud (13)

### 3. What Jesus says to believers who doubt their part in God's worldwide plans (49:14–50:3)

- We think the church is forgotten – but it couldn't be (14–18)
- We think the church is unproductive – but it won't be (19–23)
- We think the church is powerless – but God can overcome anything (24–26)
- We think God has cut us off – but are we responsive to Him drawing near? (50:1–3)
